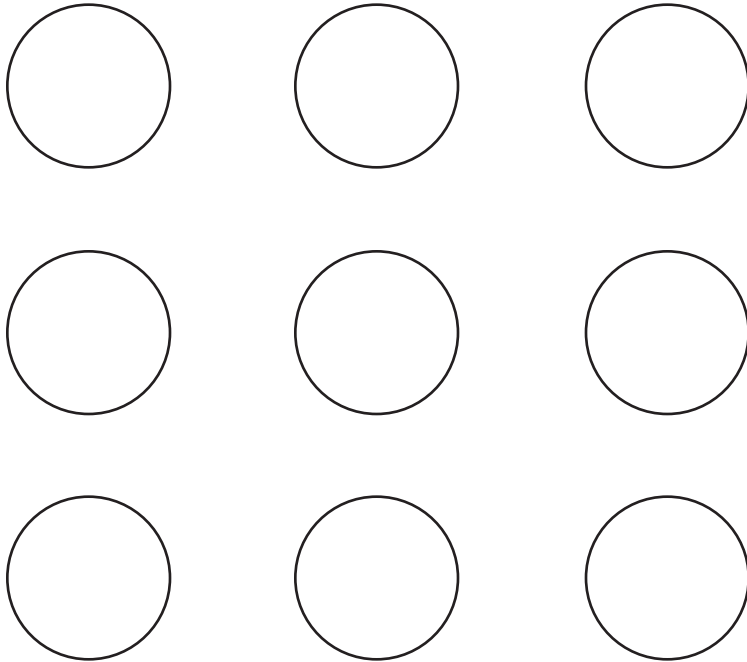


### CIRCLE TEST OF CREATIVE THINKING<sup>8</sup>

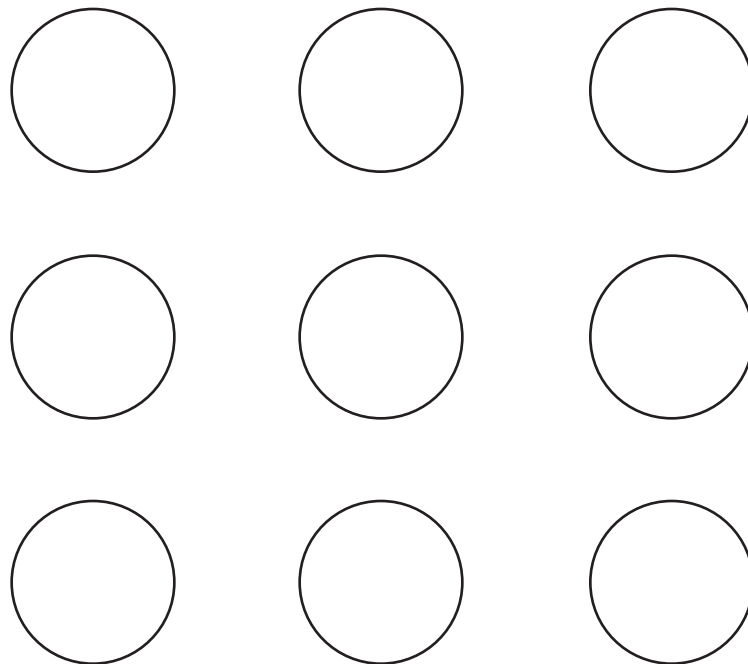
- Hesitant to begin? What's *that* about?
